 - Families were lacking in perishable items
 - Raised \$80000 and 180000 meals

Q: Senator Shamsi: what is anti-idling?

A: Idling is when a car is stagnant yet still running. We passed a resolution to have signs in front of places

Q: Senator Aznavoorian: Do you have any relevant experience and how will this help you?

A: People are unaware of many disconnects between food banks and families. I want to do this at BU, it's really prevalent here. I am very passionate about spreading awareness

Q: Senator Sharif: How will you translate this experience to the BU community?

A: One week at bu; I want to do an initiative (food drive/partnership) to increase awareness on campus

Q: Neha: Do you have any plans to work with the community service center?

A: A lot of people don't know about the food rescue service. They need more drivers for certain routes. I want to come up with a way for students to get more involved with this

Q: Senator Muwowo: Would you advertise the terrier meal share?

A: I think this is something that needs to be talked about... I had no idea about this.

Senator Garcia: You can't just go and ask for a meal. You have to talk to the dean. It doesn't just get given to anyone.

Q: Senator Aznavoorian: Can you make the above less intimidating?

A: I would definitely want to work on getting this to be more anonymous. I did this with my nonprofit... I kept things anonymous to ensure people could ask for what they actually needed.

Q: Vice President: What do you envision a garden looking like? Who will maintain this?

A: In advocacy, we are working to establish this as a project. I envisioned this as something students could come and run. Food grown would be used for BU students
